- MPS intends to return to daily face-to-face instruction DK-12 if we are in Phase 4.
- MPS is taking an aggressive approach to ensure that face-to-face instruction is conducted in a safe environment that is conducive to learning.

# ‘LOOKS LIKE’: ON THE BUS

- Every MPS bus has been sanitized with an agent that lessens the likelihood of germ attachment to surfaces
- Masks are required at all times on the bus for staff and students
  - One mask will be provided by MPS, personal masks allowed following student code of conduct guidelines.
- Temperature screened at the bus door
- Hand sanitizer applied upon entrance to bus for every student
- The bus will be deep cleaned daily and in-between routes

# ‘LOOKS LIKE’: DK - 5

- The entire school is deep cleaned daily with state-of-the-art backpack spray sanitizers
- High touch points are cleaned routinely throughout the day by trained custodial staff
- Student and staff temperature screened at the school door (one primary entrance and exit point) with tablet sensors
- One-way traffic in the hallways (markings on the floor)
- Social distancing signs and directional floor markings throughout the school
- Breakfast and lunch in the classroom
- Auxiliary instruction (art, PE, etc.) in the primary classroom (teacher travel not students.)
- Masks worn by staff at all times (face shields available)
- Students not required to wear masks during primary classroom instruction
  - One mask will be provided by MPS, personal masks allowed following code of conduct guidelines.
  - Required during travel out of room and during recess

# ‘LOOKS LIKE’: DK - 5

- Desk shield provided for every student in every classroom
- Desks are sanitized after student transitions (travel to lunch, recess, etc.)
- Hand sanitizing stations installed in every classroom and required usage at every entrance/exit.
- Water fountains turned off. Water bottle filling stations installed at every building to allow for personal bottle fills.
- Classroom ventilation with outside air where applicable
- Restroom capacity monitored
- Quarantine room established for any student or staff that is feeling ill during the school day equipped with N95 masks.
- No visitors until Phase 6
- Essential volunteers only approved by administration
- All staff (and any approved essential volunteers) follow strict screening protocols.

# 'LOOKS LIKE': 6-12

- The entire school is deep cleaned daily with state-of-the-art backpack spray sanitizers
- High touch points are cleaned routinely throughout the day by trained custodial staff
- Temperature screened at the school door (one primary entrance and exit point) with 'gateway' sensors
- One-way traffic in the hallways (markings on the floor)
- Social distancing signs and directional floor markings throughout the school
- Lunch in the cafeteria, but with social distancing and staggered periods to prevent congregation
- Students travel between classrooms, passing time is staggered to prevent congestion
- Locker usage limited to specific (and fewer) times/visits to prevent congregation
- Masks worn by staff at all times (face shields available)
- Masks worn by students at all times (face shields available)
  - One mask will be provided by MPS, personal masks allowed following code of conduct guidelines.

## MPS RETURN To WORK GUIDANCE



# ‘LOOKS LIKE’: 6-12

- Desk shield provided for every student in every classroom
  - Shields sanitized between each class period
- Desks are sanitized between each class period
- Hand sanitizing stations installed in every classroom and required usage at every entrance/exit.
- Water fountains turned off. Water bottle filling stations installed at every building to allow for personal bottle fills.
- Classroom ventilation with outside air where applicable
- Restroom capacity monitored
- Quarantine room established for any student or staff that is feeling ill during the school day equipped with N95 masks.
- No visitors until Phase 6
- Essential volunteers only approved by administration
- All staff (and any approved essential volunteers) follow strict screening protocols.

## MPS RETURN TO WORK GUIDANCE



# MPS MISC. PROCEDURE NOTES:

- No travel or assemblies until we are in Phase 6
- No mass gathering until Phase 6 (Homecoming, Dances, Tailgates, etc.)
- Locker protocols (limited or no access)
  - Staggered passing times to congregation
- Clubs and Students Organizations will follow all the same protocols established in the plan (Fundraising included)
- Choir and Band outside with 6ft + Spacing
  - Weather dependent and back-up inside plans (gym if available or alternate lessons)
- No public audiences for events or performances in Phase 4
- PE Outside
  - Weather dependent and back-up inside plans (or alternate lessons)
- K-5 Auxiliary: All on carts - except PE – teacher mobile, not students

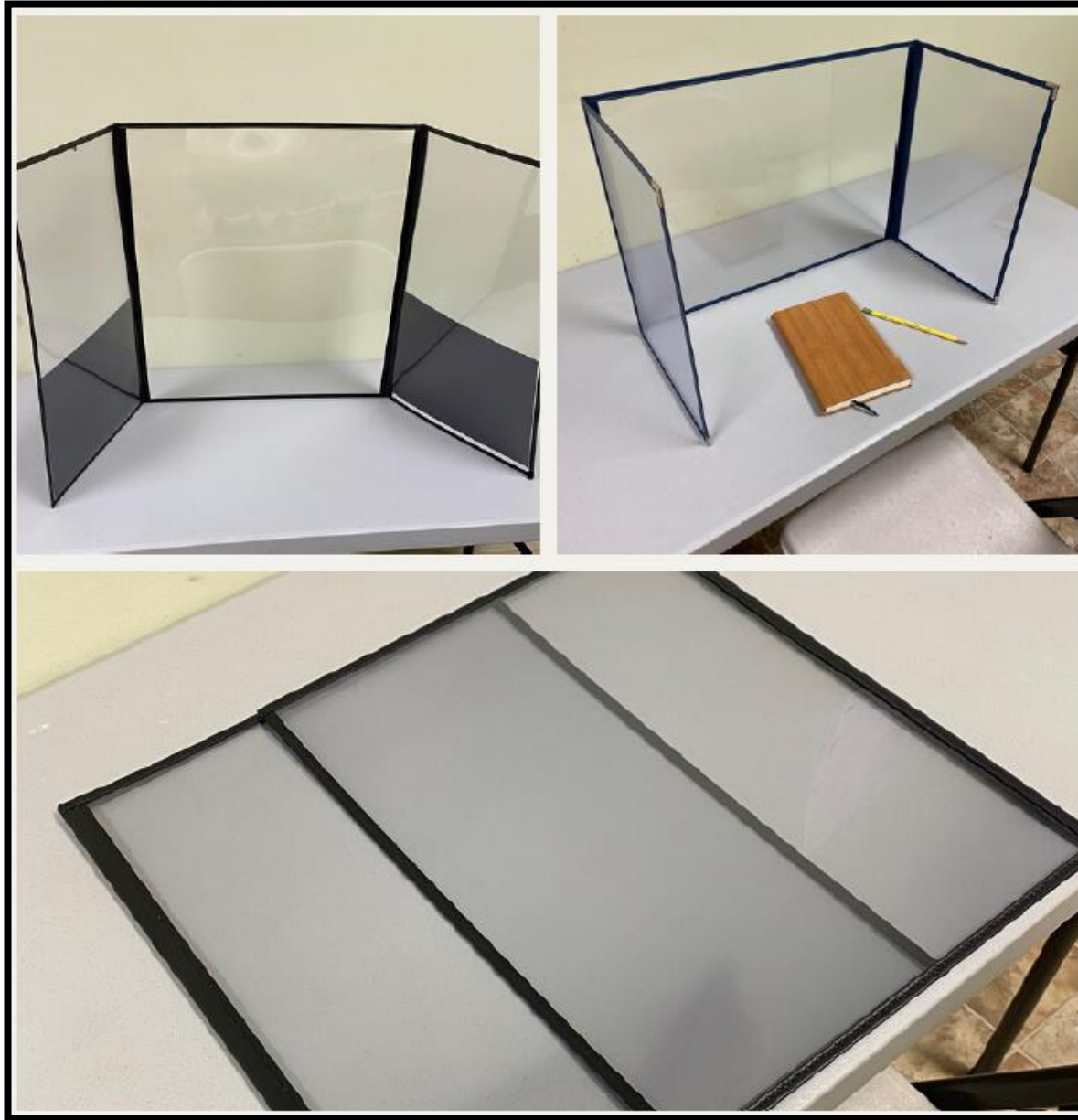
# MPS MISC. PROCEDURE NOTES:

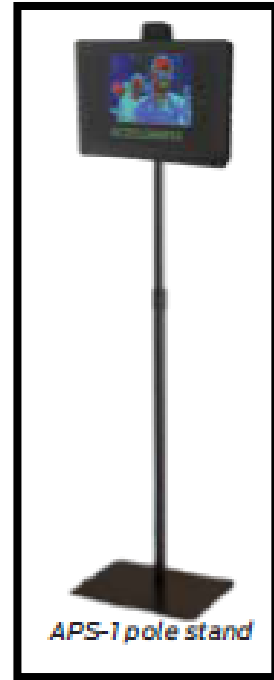
# TEMPERATURE GATES AND SENSORS:
