team competed against over 1200 students from 60 teams across Michigan and earned a 3rd place award in their Conference. Allie McMillan won the 3rd place award for High-Gun Female in Conference. At the State Competition, Marissa Berghuis won the award for 3rd place High-Gun JV Female in her division, shooting 82 (out of 100) clay targets.
