The selection committee is comprised of:

- Member of the Midland Public Schools Board of Education
- President of the Midland City Education Association (MCEA)
- Chair of the MCEA Professional Standards Committee
- MPS Administrator
- Gerstacker recipient from the previous year

After reading all of the nominations, the committee meets to discuss and make their selection. The committee members look carefully at the content of each letter. Nominees with numerous letters are not given any more importance than a few letters received about an outstanding teacher. Each year there are two elementary and two secondary recipients.

The 2022 Gerstacker recipients will be announced and celebrated at the 2022-23 Opening Staff Meeting in August.
