For the 2018-19 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

An area of emphasis for our school will continue to be to make data informed decisions and to continue to narrow achievement gaps between the top 30% of highest achieving students and the bottom 30% of lowest achieving students across tested subjects (math, reading, science, social studies, and writing).

1. Process for assigning pupils

School attendance boundaries are set by the Board of Education. All students living in the attendance area of a school attend that school unless the Schools of Choice option is selected.

2. Status of the 3-5 year school improvement plan

Our School Improvement Plan for 2018-2019 was approved by the MPS Board of Education. The plan includes academic goals for the four core curricular areas and is reviewed and revised upon the conclusion of the school year.
